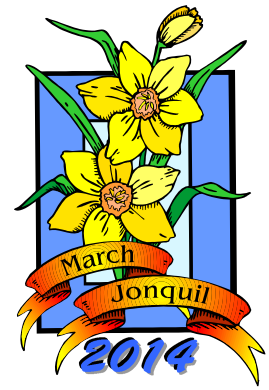

Ada Braswell Dalla Pozza, a pioneering educator who devoted decades to improving the lives of North Carolinians, especially its women and children, died Jan. 31 at the age of 91. Ada served the North Carolina Cooperative Extension Service for more than 70 years as an agent, faculty member, mentor and volunteer. She was a Past President of the NC State Woman's Club, and remained an active, contributing member until her passing. Ms. Ada, as she was affectionately known, provided leadership to improve the quality of life for families and helped create leadership institutes for rural women, many of whom became elected officials. She won numerous state and national awards and held countless leadership positions. Dalla Pozza was the *News & Observer's* Tar Heel of the Week in 1980. Betsy Meldau gave a lovely memorial for Ada at our February meeting.



Marjorie Turner passed away on February 6, 2014 at Mayview Convalescent Center in Raleigh. She was buried next to her husband, Dr. William Turner, in Raleigh Memorial Gardens. Marjorie had been in failing health this past year. She was a gracious lady who willingly gave of herself to others. The NC State Woman's Club lost a good friend whose years of service to the club will be remembered. As Reba Worsley, fellow club member and longtime friend of Marjorie, said in her tribute, "For every joy that passes, something beautiful remains." We all remember with joy the beauty of Marjorie's spirit and her ability to make us smile.
