New Special Projects

Thanks to a unanimous vote by the NCSU-WC members, a \$5,000 award has been given to the NC State Student Health Services to create the new Student Emergency Fund for Medical Needs. (\$1,613 was appropriated from the special projects fund from 2013-14, and the balance taken from the money market.)

Leah Arnett, Director of Student Health, identified that there are many of our NC State students who often have to make a choice between eating and paying for medical needs when an illness arises or prescriptions are

needed beyond what their insurance covers. This new fund will provide one-time grants of \$100 and/or up to \$250. (The \$150 balance is to be made as a loan and repaid to the fund.)

Ms. Arnett is thrilled that the NCSU Woman's Club has made this generous gift in support of the new program, and she will report on its progress and success in the spring. -- Anne Porter
