PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE



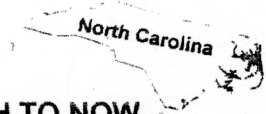

Happy Birthday, NCSU Woman's Club! Thank you again for supporting and leading this club for another 90 years! **Here's to a great 2009-2010!**

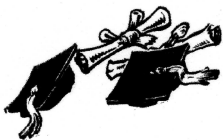
