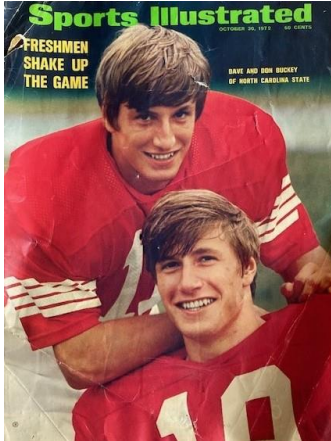

ATTENTION ALL WOLFPACK FOOTBALL FANS!

I hope we will have a huge turnout for our September 19th meeting! Our speaker will be Dave Buckey! Dave played quarterback for NC State during the Coach Lou Holtz years (1972-1975). He played the first two years as back-up quarterback and his last two years as the starting quarterback. His twin brother Don played on the team as a wide receiver.

You may remember that the twins made the cover of Sports Illustrated in 1972, which was the first year that freshmen were eligible to play on varsity teams. That incoming freshman class of 1972 still has the highest 4-year winning percentage of any class in NC State history! Those teams went to 4 straight bowl games, won the ACC Championship in 1973, and finished in the top 10 in 1974.

Dave and his twin brother Don were both elected to the All-ACC Football Team in 1975 and played in the Hula Bowl and Japan Bowl All-Star games. Dave retired from the transportation industry and currently resides in Raleigh.
