The US Air Force also sent him back to NCSU for a master's degree in Atmospheric Science. He served as a weather officer for the US Air Force for 22 years before retiring as a Lt Col. He worked eight years as a civil service meteorologist for the Department of the Air Force and Army Support around the world.
